A person any age can make a difference in the life of a child!

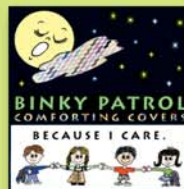

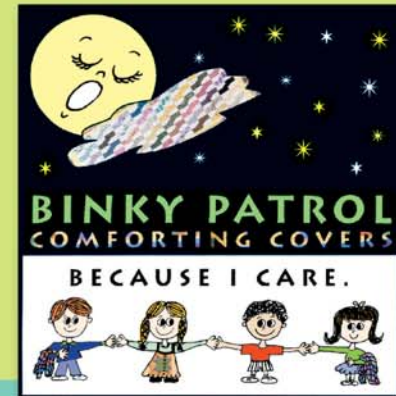
"About a month ago, I saw on the news where a 9-yr-old girl was attacked by three older kids as she got off the bus. They held her down and smashed her hand with a brick.
